


Illustration shows

at a high-level



Achieving Student objectives will require an ecosystem approach with a high degree of business process and external system to system integration, as well as a consolidated cross-platform user experience








Timeline

Business Function Milestones When UBC starts using the Workday feature and completing business process transactions in Workday






We are one integrated team dedicated to delivering a transformed Student ecosystem and supporting the UBC community throughout the transition



- Based on lessons learned from IRP R1, IRP Student has adopted a One Program model
- We are organized in cross-functional teams that are aligned across end-to-end business capabilities
- Benefits of the approach include the resolution of many issues related to schedule, conflicting priorities, and communications
- The new model emphasizes opportunities for UBC staff, minimizing the need for consultants and contractors
- The One Program approach is focused on a culture of collaboration, openness, adaptability, and excellence

IRP Student Ramp Up

- 100+ new positions:
 - Project managers (I, II and Senior)
 - Business analysts (I, II and Senior)
 - Developers
 - Integration analysts
 - Test leads and analysts
 - Change management and communications leads and specialists
 - Training specialists
- Most will be ongoing positions funded through 2024
- Secondments can be arranged where possible
- Postings will begin appearing in Workday soon
