


How is Workday Student Tested?

IRP Student has been rigorously testing the new system's components every step of the way to ensure functionality prior to Launch. The Testing process seeks to confirm that the system works as designed, and that it meets the University's needs to ensure business continuity. IRP Student employs three main types of Testing: Unit Testing, Integration Testing, and End-to-End Testing (E2E).
